



OMNI HOTEL | MEP | CASE STUDY

1-year partnership leads to huge resort improvements.

FACTS

Omni wanted to connect an existing tower with a new tower and conference center by building a central lobby.

Beck is the Architect and contractor for the renovations and new construction. Big Red Dog, a division of WGI was brought on to optimize efficiency using lean design processes.

Being a premiere destination for golfing, the resort will stay open during construction and renovation.

BACKGROUND

In 2013, Omni Resorts bought Barton Creek Resort & Spa in West Austin. The 312-room property also included four golf courses, a conference center, and a ballroom. Omni set out to renovate the existing property and build new facilities. BIG RED DOG was brought on as the MEP engineer for the design of a new tower, clubhouse, conference center and parking garage and more.

RESULTS

Big Red Dog, a division of WGI's MEP team used lean design theories and Big Room practices to design systems that would allow Omni to use existing systems and tie them into new systems.
